

Scottish Honey Labelling Regulations - quick guide from DSBA association

Must contain the word 'honey'


DSBKA Honey


Illustrations must not mislead. Can not have a picture of heather on the label if it is not heather honey etc.

Label must have country of origin, not sufficient to have it in the address




Blossom Honey
Product of Stirling,
 Scotland

Can specify the type of honey: blossom, heather, creamed etc. Remember that it must be at least 75% of that type of honey

If selling or giving away, must have the name and address - doesn't need to be complete but you need to be traceable from the info you provide

 University of Stirling,
FK9 4LA

Weight must be on the label and in metric - this is net weight

 454 grams L001 

If selling or giving way, a lot number must be present

Best Before April 2023 

Best before date - standard is 2-5 years

Not suitable for children under 12 months 

Good to state that honey is not suitable for children under 12 months
